Face-to-face support, advocacy and advice for families affected by child exploitation.



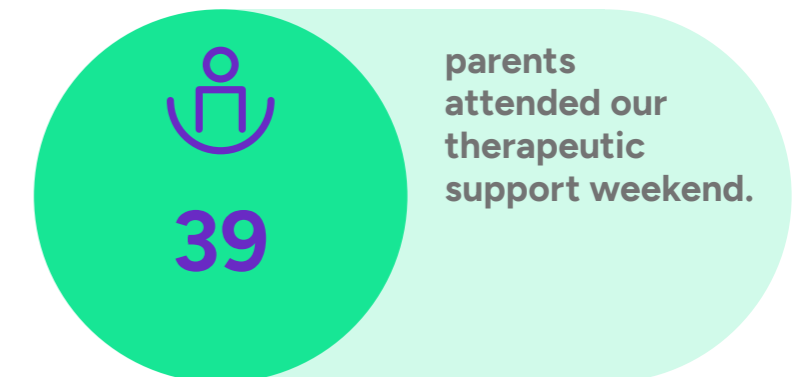
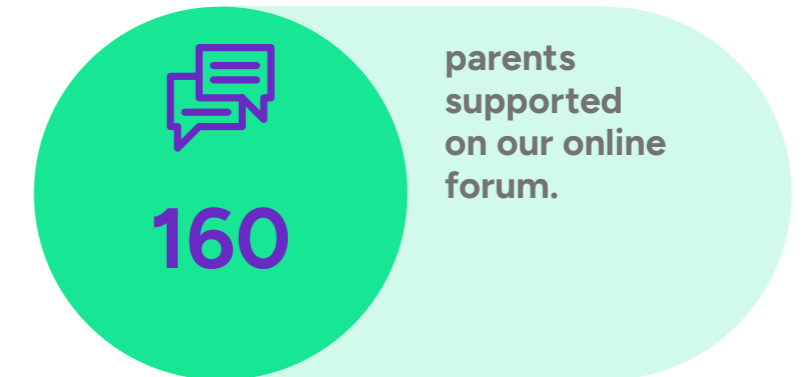
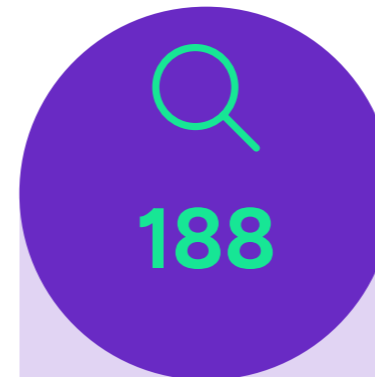
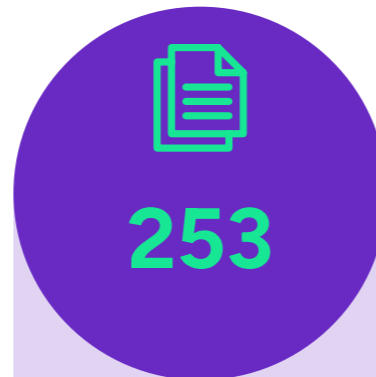
